#### **YARN**

## Rowan Purelife British Sheep Breeds Boucle

9 9 10 10 11 x100gm (Photographed in Ecru)

#### Needles

1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles 1 pair 8mm (no 0) (US11) needles

#### Buttons -1

# Tension

 $8\frac{1}{2}$  sts and 13 rows to 10cm measured over st st using 8mm (US 11) needles.

#### BACK

Using 7mm (US 10 ½) needles cast on 50 [54: 58: 62: 70] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** P2, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 8 rows, dec 3 [3: 1: 1: 3] sts evenly across last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 47 [51:57:61:67] sts. Change to 8mm (US11) needles.

Beg at K row, now work in st st, shaping side seams by dec 1 st at each end of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 3 foll 8<sup>th</sup> rows. 39 [43: 49: 53: 59] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 36 [37: 38: 39: 40] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape armholes

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 35 [39: 45: 49: 55] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [1: 3: 3: 5] rows, then foll 1 [2: 2: 3: 2] rows. 31 [33: 35: 37: 41] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 19 [20: 21: 22: 23] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape back neck and shoulder

**Next row (RS):** Cast off 4 [4: 4: 5: 6] sts, K until there are 7 [8: 8: 8: 9] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 4 [5: 5: 5: 6] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 9 [9: 11: 11: 11] sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reverse shapings.

#### LEFT FRONT

Using 7mm (US 10½) needles cast on 23 [23: 27: 31: 31] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2. \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**Row 2:** K2, P2 \*K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 8 rows, dec 2 [0: 1: 3: 0] sts evenly across last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 21 [23: 26: 28: 31] sts. Change to 8mm (US11) needles.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st, shaping side seam by dec 1 st at beg of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 3 foll 8<sup>th</sup> rows. 17 [19: 22: 24: 27] sts. Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape armhole

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. 15 [17: 20: 22: 25] sts. Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 1 [1: 3: 3: 5] rows, then on foll 1 [1: 3: 3: 5] rows, then on foll 1 [2: 2: 3: 2] rows. 13 [14: 15: 16: 18] sts. Cont straight until 7 [7: 7: 7: 9] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

#### Shape neck

Cast off 1 [1: 2: 2: 2] sts at beg f next row. 12 [13: 13: 14: 17] sts. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows, then foll 1 [1: 1: 1: 2] alt rows. 8 [9: 9: 10: 12] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 [4: 4: 5: 6] sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 [5: 5: 5: 6] sts.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Using 7mm (US 10½) needles cast on 27 [31: 31: 35: 39] sts.

**Row** (**RS**): K3, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P2, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 8 rows, dec 1 [3: 0: 2: 3] sts evenly across last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 26 [28: 31: 33: 36] sts. Change to 8mm (US 11) needles.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st, shaping side seam by dec 1 st at end of 3<sup>rd</sup> row and 3 foll 8<sup>th</sup> rows. 22 [24: 27: 29: 32] sts.

Cont straight until right front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

#### Shaping armhole

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. 20 [22: 25: 27: 30] sts.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next of next 1 [1: 3: 3: 5] rows, then on foll 1 [2: 2: 3: 2] rows. 18 [19: 20: 21: 23] sts.

Cont straight until 6 [6: 6: 6: 8] rows less have been worked than back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape neck

Cast off 6 [6: 7: 7: 6] sts at beg of next row. 12 [13: 13: 14: 17] sts. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows, then on foll 1 [1: 1: 1: 2] alt rows. 8 [9: 9: 10: 12] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

#### Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 [4: 4: 5: 6] sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 [5: 5: 5: 6] sts.

#### SLEEVES

Using 7mm (US 10½) needles cast on 26 [26: 26: 26: 30] sts.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for back, inc 1 st at each end of 7<sup>th</sup> [ 7<sup>th</sup>: 5<sup>th</sup>: 5<sup>th</sup>: 5<sup>th</sup>] and 1 [1: 1: 2: 2] foll 8<sup>th</sup> [8<sup>th</sup>: 8<sup>th</sup>: 6<sup>th</sup>: 6<sup>th</sup>] rows, taking inc sts into rib. 30 [30: 30: 32: 36] sts.

Work a further 5 [5: 7: 3: 3] rows, dec 3 [1: 1: 1: 3] sts evenly across

last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 27 [29:29:31:33] sts. Change to 8mm (US 11) needles.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of  $3^{rd}$  [ $3^{rd}$ : next:  $3^{rd}$ :  $3^{rd}$ ] and every foll  $8^{th}$  [ $8^{th}$ :  $8^{th}$ :  $6^{th}$ :  $6^{th}$ : row to 33 [33: 39: 35: 37] sts, then on every foll  $10^{th}$  [ $10^{th}$ : -:  $8^{th}$ :  $8^{th}$ ] row until there are 35 [37: -: 41: 43] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 44 [45: 46: 46: 46] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape top

Cast off 2 st at beg of next 2 rows. 31 [33: 35: 37: 39] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 6 [7: 8: 9: 10] rows ending with RS

[WS: RS: WS: RS] facing for next row. 19sts.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 11 sts.

#### MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

#### Left front band

With RS facing and using 7mm (US 10½) needles, pick up and knit 42 [46: 46: 50: 50] sts evenly down left front opening edge.

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, P2, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**Row 2:** K3, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 2 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off in rib (on WS)

#### Right front band

With RS facing and using 7mm (US 101/2) needles, pick up and knit 42 [46: 46: 50: 50] sts evenly up right front opening edge. Work in rib as given for left front band for 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Row 2 (RS): Rib to last 4 sts, yon, K2tog (to make buttonhole), K2

Work in rib for a further 2 rows, ending with  $\mathbf{WS}$  facing for next row.

Cast off in rib (on **WS**).

#### Collar

With RS facing and using 7mm (US 10 ½) needles, beg and ending at cast-off edges of front bands, pick up and knit 15 [15: 16: 16: 17] sts up right side of neck, 15 [15: 17: 17: 17] sts from back, then 10 [10: 11: 11: 12] sts down left side of neck. 40 [40: 44: 44: 46] sts.

**Row 1 (RS of collar, WS of body):** K2 [2: 4: 4: 4], inc in next st, (K4 [4: 4: 4: 3], inc in next st) 7 [7: 7: 7: 9] times, K2 [2: 4: 4: 5]. 48 [48: 52: 52: 56] sts.

Beg with row 1, cont in rib as given for left front band until cast off **loosely** in rib.
